There will be WRDX, WD and WRD testing on Saturday & Sunday. The Entries are limited to 25 dogs with a minimum of 5 entries. 5 of the 25 entries are reserved for WRDX entries. If there are not 5 WRDX entries the remainder of the entries will be filled with WD and WRD entrants.

Entries from within the United States will be accepted by US Postal Service mail only and priority will be given to entrants who have not earned titles in the division entered.

ENTRIES FROM MEMBERS OF THE NEWFOUNDLAND CLUB OF AMERICA WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH POSTMARKS JULY 24, 2018 OR LATER.

ENTRIES FROM NON-MEMBERS OF THE NEWFOUNDLAND CLUB OF AMERICA WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH POSTMARKS AUGUST 3, 2018 OR LATER

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF POSTMARKED PRIOR TO THESE DATES.

ENTRIES CLOSE ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 AT 6:00 PM. AT THE TEST SECRETARY'S HOME AFTER WHICH TIME ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELLED, SUBSTITUTED OR ALTERED EXCEPT AS DESCRIBED IN THE NCA WATER TEST REGULATIONS.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the NCA test regulations have been made available to me (us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary and the owner or leaser of the premises or grounds and the employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage, or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other causes.

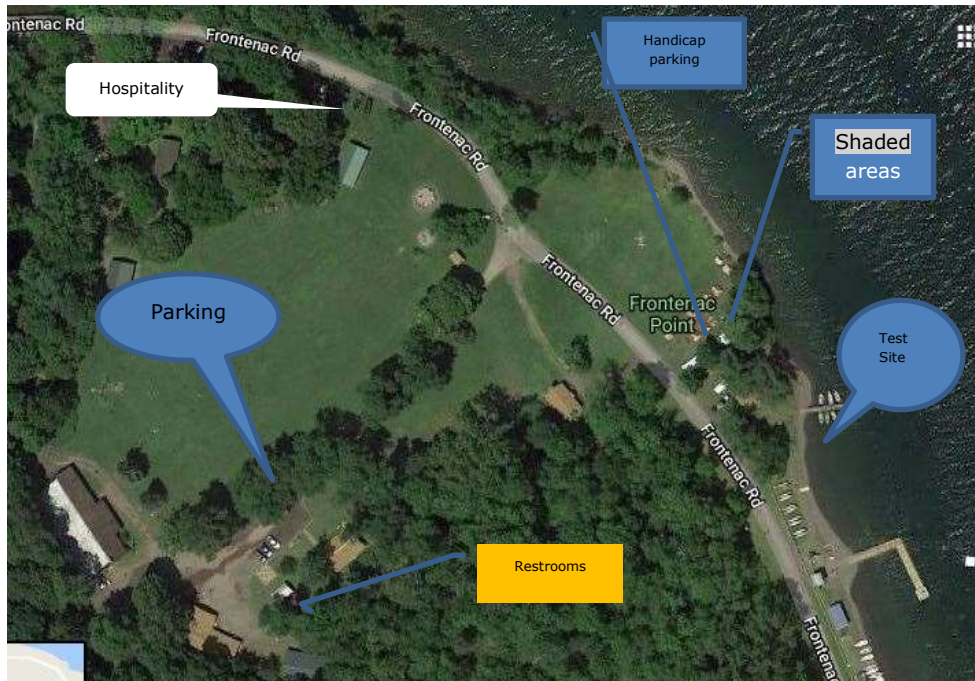

Test Site

The Water Test is at Camp Barton on the West Shores of Cayuga Lake. Hospitality is North West 500 feet of the test site in a pavilion. There is parking 550 feet West of test site, you will be able to unload your crates at the site, some handicap parking is available PLEASE notify the TEST Secretary what provisions you will need. All others will park near the restrooms and walk down to the test site. There is a shaded lawn next to the Site where you can set up crates. A Safety Officer Shall be notified on the locations of all dogs attending the event!



*** NCA Dog Aggression Policy ***

"Any dog that in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated. "

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season will not be allowed on the test site until just prior to being judged, which will be after all other dogs are tested. When not being tested, bitches in season must be contained in a designated area away from the official test areas. If you are entering a bitch, do you anticipate she might be in season? As a courtesy, please inform the Test Secretary prior to the test.

Spectators and Non-entered Dogs

Spectators as well as non-entered dogs (except bitches in season) are welcome at the GRNC Water Test. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet and leashed or crated. The Safety Office Shall be notified of all locations of Non-entered dogs.

Safety Observances

Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times.

When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed SIX feet and may NOT be a retractable leash.

When on leash dogs must be under control at all times.

Dogs showing uncontrolled or aggressive behavior will be asked by the event chair, a board member, safety officer or other official to leave the site promptly or be crated for the duration of the test.

East/West on I-90 NY State Thruway—Take the RT 414 S **Exit 41** toward Waterloo/Clyde Waterloo/Seneca Falls. In .8 miles merge onto NY 414 South / Ridge Rd. In .3 miles turn left on NY 318. In 4.1 miles turn left onto US-20 E. In 446 feet Turn right at the 1st cross street onto NY-89 South In 30.5 Miles Turn Left onto Frontenac Road in 0.6 miles your Destination will be on the Right.
